



What does an Interior Designer Do for their Clients?

1. Analyzes the client's needs, goals, health, welfare and life safety requirements.
2. Integrates findings with knowledge of Interior Design
3. Formulates design concepts that are appropriate, functional, aesthetic and creative.
4. Develops and presents final design recommendations through appropriate presentation method/media.
5. Prepares working drawings and specifications for non-load bearing interior construction, materials, finishes, space planning, furnishings, fixtures, and equipment.
6. Collaborates with other licensed practitioners who offer professional services in the technical areas of mechanical, electrical, and load bearing design as required for regulatory approval.
7. Prepares and administers bids and contract documents as the client's agent.
8. Evaluates design solutions during implementation and upon completion.
